Philippians 2:5 You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. 6 Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. 7 Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, 8 he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross. *NLT*

For Reflection & Application:

Monday:

Christian exclusivity the idea that the God of the Bible is the one true God, and Jesus Christ is the only way to be made right with God. Does such exclusivity seem intolerant and hateful? Why or why not? Is Christian exclusivity biblical?

Tuesday:

Christian supremacy is a religious ideology that is based upon the belief that Christian people are superior in many ways to people of other religions and that therefore, Christian people should be dominant over other religions. Does such supremacy seem intolerant and hateful? Why or why not? Is Christian supremacy biblical?

Wednesday:

Few would admit to being a Christian supremacist, but do you see evidence of Christian supremacy in our culture and in your own life? How does the attitude of Christian supremacy affect the message of Christian exclusivity? Do you see any similarities between white supremacy and Christian supremacy?

Thursday:

Read Philippians 2:3-8. How does Christian humility embodied by Jesus compare with Christian supremacy?

Friday:

In what ways and in which relationships do you see room for personal growth in Christian humility? How can you grow in humility?

Daily Prayer:

Lord, search my heart and see if there is any Christian supremacy that needs to be replaced with Christian humility. I don't want my bad attitude to get in the way of your good news. Amen.
