## Big Idea:

Text questions during the sermon: 623-850-8809

**Psalm 139:13** For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb.  
*ESV*

## For Reflection and Application:

Monday:

Whether you are Pro-Life or Pro-Choice, how would you defend your position? What specific Scriptures are relevant to your position, and how do you interpret them?

Tuesday:

Whether you are Pro-Life or Pro-Choice, what are the three strongest arguments *against* your own position? Reflect on the possible circumstances and stories and feelings that may help explain how your opponents came to their point of view. Read a book or an article that opposes your view.

Wednesday:

Read John 1:14. Jesus is described as “full of grace and truth.” How does this relate to whatever position you take on abortion?

Thursday:

Read Psalm 103:12; 1 John 1:9; 1 Peter 2:24. How do these verses relate to those who have had an abortion?

Friday:

Do Pro-Life and Pro-Choice advocates both want social justice? If so, do you think is there some common ground that can be taken to reduce abortions? How can we together alleviate certain causes of abortion? What are some possibilities?

Daily Prayer:

Lord I want to represent you well, particularly in conversations about abortion. Help me to reflect the fullness of both truth and grace that you embody in the person of Jesus Christ, in whose name I pray. Amen.
