Obadiah 1:10 Because of the violence done to your brother Jacob, shame shall cover you, and you shall be cut off forever. II On the day that you stood aloof, on the day that strangers carried off his wealth and foreigners entered his gates and cast lots for Jerusalem, you were like one of them. 12 But do not gloat over the day of your brother in the day of his misfortune; do not rejoice over the people of Judah in the day of their ruin; do not boast in the day of distress. 13 Do not enter the gate of my people in the day of their calamity; do not gloat over his disaster in the day of his calamity; do not loot his wealth in the day of his calamity. 14 Do not stand at the crossroads to cut off his fugitives; do not hand over his survivors in the day of distress. 15 For the day of the LORD is near upon all the nations. As you have done, it shall be done to you; your deeds shall return on your own head. ESV

For Reflection and Application:

Monday:

Read Obadiah 1:10-15. List all the specific sins committed by Edom/Esau against Jacob/Judah. According to verse 15, how and when will Edom be judged? Will the judgment be proportional?

Tuesday:

Read Matthew 11:23-24; John 19:10-11. What do these verses suggest about the judgment of those who are not saved? Will they all experience the same thing?

Wednesday:


Read 2 Corinthians 5:10; I John 2:28; Matthew 16:27. According these verses, will believers be judged? If so, when, and how? Will all believers experience the same thing? What is at stake?

Thursday:

How do you feel about the prospect of being judged one day? How do you reconcile this with being saved by faith?

Friday:

If God will judge everyone by works, even those who are saved, what difference does this make in your life?
