For Reflection and Application:

Monday:

Read Romans 12:10. What does it mean to honor another person? Do you think honoring one another is related to loving one another? Why or why not?

Tuesday:

Read 1 Corinthians 6:19, 1 Peter 1:18, and Philippians 2:3. What do these verses suggest concerning how much we should honor others? What would that look like? Read 1 Peter 2:17. According to this verse, who should we honor?

Wednesday:

Read Romans 13:1-7 and 1 Peter 2:17. What do these verses suggest about who we should honor in the political arena? How can you apply this?

Thursday:

Read 1 Peter 3:7, Ephesians 5:33, and Ephesians 6:2. What do these verses suggest about who we should honor in our families? How can you apply this?

Friday:

Read 1 Timothy 6:1 and Philemon 1:16. What do these verses suggest about who we should honor in the workplace? How can you apply this? Read 1 Timothy 5:1, 3, 17; James 2:6; and 1 Corinthians 12:23. What do these verses suggest about who we should honor in the church? How can you apply this?
