Galatians 6:1 Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness.

Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted. 2 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

3 For if anyone thinks he is something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself.

4 But let each one test his own work, and then his reason to boast will be in himself alone and not in his neighbor. 5 For each will have to bear his own load.

Monday:

Read Galatians 6:1-5. In verse 2, Paul says, "Bear one another's burdens."

Tuesday:

In the last part of Galatians 6:1, what is the specific temptation that we are watch out for as we seek to restore?

Wednesday:

From Galatians 6:2, how does bearing one another's burdens fulfill the law of Christ?

Thursday:

What does Galatians 6:3-4 have to say about Christians comparing and competing with each other as a basis for approval? How does this relate to bearing one another's burdens?

Friday:

How do you reconcile Galatians 6:2 with Galatians 6:5?

Lord, help me to bear another's burdens with the aim of restoration and with the spirit of gentleness and humility, thus fulfilling the law of Christ. Amen.
