For Reflection and Application:

Monday:

Read Romans 15:5-6. Why is living in harmony with one another important, according to this text?

Tuesday:

Read Romans 15:5-6 in various translations of the Bible. Now read parallel verses in Romans 12:16; 2 Corinthians 13:11; Philippians 2:2; 4:2. What does it mean to live in harmony with one another?

Wednesday:

In Romans 15:5, what is the significance of the qualifier, “in accord with Christ Jesus”? What does this suggest about our purpose in life and how it relates to living in harmony with one another?

Thursday:

Read John 6:38, 40; 10:10; 20:21. What do these verses suggest about our purpose in life and being “in accord with Christ Jesus”?

Friday:

In what specific ways can you live in harmony with others in the church today?

Daily Prayer:

Lord, help us to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, that together we may with one voice glorify you. Amen.
