Sermon Notes

Psalm 118:

- 1 Oh give thanks to the LORD, for he is good;
for his steadfast love endures forever!
- 2 Let Israel say,
“His steadfast love endures forever.”
- 3 Let the house of Aaron say,
“His steadfast love endures forever.”
- 4 Let those who fear the LORD say,
“His steadfast love endures forever.”

Big Idea:

Psalm 118:1 Oh give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; for his steadfast love endures forever! *ESV*

For Reflection and Application:

Monday:

Read Psalm 118:1-4. By repetition, what seems to be the big idea from these verses? Be still for a moment and meditate on this idea. Read the repeated refrain again and again emphasizing a different word each time.

Tuesday:

In Psalm 118:1, the psalmist says, “Oh give thanks to the LORD, for he is good . . .” List some ways that the Lord has been good and carry it with you today. Prayerfully give thanks for what is on the list.

Wednesday:

In Psalm 118:1-4, the psalmist says again and again of *Yahweh*, “his steadfast love endures forever.” What specific evidence from do you see in Scripture or your life that this is true?

Thursday:

Historically, Psalm 118 was sung by ancient Jews after a period of anxiety and after celebrating the Passover meal. Why do you think Psalm 118 is good for these purposes?

Friday:

Reread Psalm 118:1-4. In what way does this speak to you today? What difference does it make in your life?

Daily Prayer:

I give thanks to you, O Lord, for you are good; for your steadfast love endures forever. Amen.
