For Reflection and Application:

Monday:

Our passage this week tells us that because of the Son's obedience and sacrifice, God the Father has highly exalted His Son. What exactly does this mean? How does this impact you and your life?

Tuesday:

Our passage this week tells us that because of the Son's obedience and sacrifice, God the Father has given His Son a name which is above every name. What exactly does this mean? How does this impact you and your life?

Wednesday:

Our passage this week tells us that God has given Jesus a name that is above all names. Why is this important? How does this relate to salvation? How does this impact you and your life?

Thursday:

Our passage this week tells us that because of the Son's obedience and sacrifice, God the Father has decreed that one day, everyone will bow down and confess that Jesus is Lord. How does this impact you and your life?

Friday:

Our passage this week tells that the Father has made the Son to be Head of all things, including the church. We looked at setting Jesus as our Chief Cornerstone and aligning our lives and our church on that. How do we align our lives and Moon Valley Bible with our Chief Cornerstone? In other words, how can we ensure that our beliefs line up with Jesus and His Word? How does this impact you and your life?
